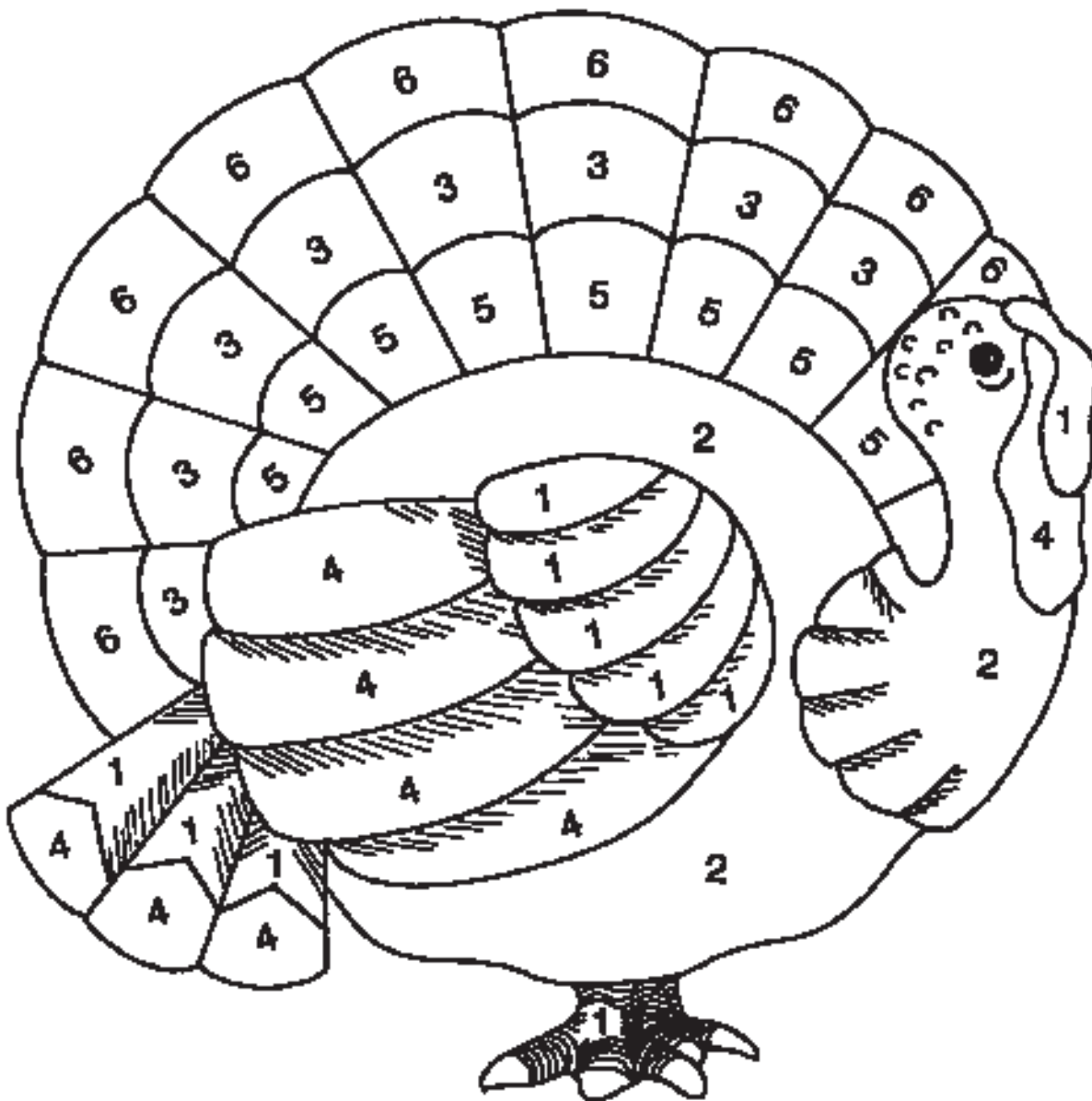

Thanksgiving Napkin Rings

Materials:

- markers or crayons
- scissors
- glue
- toilet paper tube



Directions:

1. Cut a toilet paper tube into four equal parts.
2. Reproduce napkin ring patterns below onto white construction paper. Color and cut out the napkin ring patterns.
3. Apply glue to the wrong side of each pattern and form a ring shape around each toilet tube piece. (See diagram.)
4. Put paper or cloth napkins in the rings for a Thanksgiving gift!
